Florida Aging Road User Survey

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Executive Summary

A telephone and internet survey was conducted to identify the habits, needs and concerns of Florida's aging road users, and to assess how these changed since 2011 and 2012. The survey investigated drivers' and other road users' characteristics; their opinions regarding the safety of Florida's roads; their plans for when they can no longer safely drive; and their knowledge of the Coalition, local transportation options, CarFit events, and driver safety courses. Perceptive Market Research of Gainesville, FL, administered the survey to a random sample of 1,056 Florida residents, approximately half of whom are between age 50 and 65 and another half are 65 and older.

Key findings from the survey:

- Most aging road users consider Florida's roads to be very or somewhat safe (vs. somewhat or very unsafe). The percent rating the state's roads as very safe increased in the past year from 16 to 20 percent among between age 50 and 64, and from 19 to 22 among those age 65 and older.
- The common types of distracted driving continue to be eating or drinking, although the percent of 50- to 64-year olds reporting they eat or drink while driving decreased from 64 to 54 percent from 2012 to 2013. Talking on a cell phone without a hands-free device is also fairly common in the younger group, but it too decreased in the past year (46% in 2012, 38% in 2013). Few (< 5%) older road users report that they text while driving.
- Around 14 percent of drivers 65 and older say they almost always or frequently drive more than 10 miles per hour under the speed limit, with little change in the past year.
- When asked what physical aspect of roads made it hardest to drive, both groups were more likely to mention night-time reflections off roadway devices. This increased from around 35 percent of aging road users in 2012 to 41 percent in 2013.
- In addition to driving, aging drivers get around in their communities mostly by riding with family and friends or walking. Non-drivers primarily get around using family and friends. These remain relatively unchanged in the past year.
- There has been no change in the percent of older drivers who have spoken to a health professional in the past year about their ability to drive safely – around 4 percent of those age 50 to 64, and only 6 percent of those 65 and older. This is true despite the fact that around 15 percent older drivers have been involved in a crash in the past 5 years.
- Around 13 percent reported they have planned ahead for the day when they can no longer safely drive (8% of the younger group, 18% of those 65 and older). This is almost the same as 2012. When asked what they might do to get around if they couldn't drive, the most common plan in both years is to rely on family and friends (65%).
- A bigger percent of non-drivers in 2013 said they had not driven in the past month because they no longer have a driver license: 23 percent in 2013 vs. 14 percent in 2012.
- More non-drivers are satisfied (72%) than are not satisfied (28%) with their ability to get around their communities, and the percent satisfied increased from 2012 to 2013.

- Among those with older family members who currently drive, about 28 percent said they were somewhat or very concerned about that family member's ability to drive safely – this is a small drop from 31 percent in 2012. Fewer (22%) had talked to their family member about ways to improve their safety, and around 27% had talked with them about other ways to get around. Both of these are also slightly lower than the percents found in 2012 (26% and 30%, respectively).
- Surprisingly, fewer older road users were interested in receiving information about safe driving and transportation alternatives -- around 36 percent were in 2012, and that dropped to 29 percent in 2013. The best way to be contacted included direct mail, e-mail, and newspaper ads/articles.
- Similar to 2012, around one percent had visited the Safe and Mobile Seniors website in the past year. However, the percent who were aware of the coalition increased modestly among the 65 plus population. In 2012, around 11 percent of those 65 and older had heard of the Safe Mobility for Life Coalition, and this number increased to 13 percent in 2013.
- Awareness of CarFit events and programs continues to be low; fewer than 5 percent had heard of CarFit in the past 12 months in both 2012 and 2013. Lack of knowledge of CarFit events was the number one reason given for not attending such an event, followed by the perception that they did not need to attend CarFit.
- Around half of aging road users are aware of driver safety courses, while 34 percent know of the insurance discount that comes with completing a certified course. As expected, awareness of both was higher among the 65 and older road users. Older road users are not more aware of these programs than they were in 2012.

Sampling design, data collection, and sample characteristics

The data collection for Florida State University-FDOT Safety and Mobility Survey 2013, took place at Perceptive Market Research, Inc., in Gainesville, Florida, between July 10, 2013 and August 25, 2013. The sample consisted of 7,425 numbers of adults in Florida which included an oversample of 1,500 numbers of adults in the following four counties: Alachua, Collier, Columbia and Dade (Miami-Dade) in order to reach the quota of 75 in each.

As a result of the telephone calls 906 interviews were completed with adults in Florida 50+ years old and 150 interviews were completed online with adults in Florida 50+ years old for a total of 1,056 interviews. The average length of the telephone interview with respondents was 14 minutes. Each number in the sample was attempted for an average of 6 to 7 times.

For this although we used oversample the population of the 4 following counties: Alachua, Collier, Columbia and Dade (Miami-Dade), it is important to note that in order to have the sample be representative of the racial distribution in the state of Florida there has to be an oversample of both the African-American population as well as the Hispanic population as well.

The telephone interview was conducted using the computer-assisted telephone interviewing system (CATI) at our offices.

The record of telephone call dials for the sample was as follows:

The respondents are geographically dispersed across the state, residing in 58 different counties (see responses to Question #46).

In terms of other sample characteristics, 59.9% were female and 40.1% were male, while 86.3% self-identified as white, 7.1% black, 4.9% Hispanic, and the remainder identified as other race/ethnic groups or refused.

Despite the older age of the sample, few respondents who passed the initial screen and agreed to be interviewed found the survey difficult to complete (see Q48-Q50 below). According to notes recorded by interviewers after the completion of the phone interviews or after screening those who elected to complete the internet version of the questionnaire, 93% had good or excellent understanding of the questions (vs. fair or poor), 98% seemed to be either a little or not at all tired by the interview (vs. very tiring), and 92% required only a little or no repetition of the questions (vs. some or a lot).
